### CONCERT: FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### **What time will the show start?**

Doors open at 5:30 p.m. and music will start around 6:30 p.m.

#### **How long is the concert?**

Music will begin at around 6:30 p.m. and wrap up just before 11 p.m.

#### **Where is the concert?**

The concert will take place on the corner of Main St. & Fairford St. East at the Moose Jaw City Hall Intersection.

#### **Are there assigned seats for ticket holders?**

No, where you stand will depend on the time you arrive and how others before you have situated themselves. We recommend arriving early for closer proximity to stage. Doors will open at 5:30 p.m.

#### **Can I still catch the concert from outside the venue?**

Yes! We will be shutting down between Fairford St. East (starting from outside of the concert entry gate) and Langdon Crescent for the duration of the show for people to enjoy the sights and sounds. Places are not reserved, and you do not need a ticket to view the concert from this location. The area may fill up quickly. Upon arrival, please wait near the non-ticket holder area (located east of the entry gates) so to not crowd the concert entry area.

#### **Can I bring food, furniture or large bags?**

Please do not bring outside food and beverage, furniture of any kind (i.e. folding lawn chairs), coolers, umbrellas, pets, large items such as backpacks, duffle bags etc. For ticket holders, food trucks will be available on-site for food purchase.

#### **How many pieces of ID will be required at the door?**

You will be required to present one piece of government issued photo ID. ID will be checked to ensure all guests are over 19.

#### **Does the name on the ticket need to match the name of the ticket holder at the entrance?**

No, the name on the ticket does not need to match the name on the ticket holder's ID at the entrance. We understand that the person who purchased the ticket may not always be the concert attendee.

#### **Are food and drink available?**

A bar and a variety of food trucks will be present on-site for drink and food purchase.

#### **Are there transportation arrangements?**

The City of Moose Jaw will be providing free transit service in conjunction with the One Horse Town concert. Free transit service will be offered following the concert (not before). There will be two rounds of service, the first at 10:40 p.m. and the second at 11:20 p.m. Buses will be lined up on Langdon Crescent north of Fairford St. East. We encourage all attendees to enjoy the concert, but please do not drink and drive. Use the free transit service to get home safely.
